It is anticipated the program can take up to 24 months to complete.

COURSE / CAREER DETAILS

This Australian Apprenticeship is designed to provide people who are entering the Automotive Industry with specialist Accessory Fitting skills and qualifications.

This vocation may involve many practical tasks including fitting tow bars, bull bars and roof racks.

It may also be necessary to install test and repair wiring circuits on trailers and caravans and to fit some electrical components such as driving lights.

Some fabrication of components and manufacturing of brackets may be necessary requiring welding, heating and thermal cutting.

Accessory Fitters often specialize in four wheel drive work which could also include the manufacture and installation of side steps, under vehicle guards, additional spare wheel carriers and long range fuel tanks.

There may also be a requirement to assemble components and equipment and fix them to vehicles and machinery.

Trainees will be required to operate within a safe working environment. Good customer contact and communication skills are also an important aspect of this Australian Apprenticeship.

This vocation can provide numerous career paths including:

- Specialising as a Qualified Accessory Fitter
- Supervision or Management of an Accessory Fitting Specialist Business
- Continue studying and gain Automotive Mechanical Technology Qualifications
