The training is available using a number of delivery options designed to meet your specific requirements. These options are:

2. Block Release, 1 week per month
3. A combination of above with on-site training and assessment
4. Open Learning training delivery with on-site training and assessment

It is anticipated the program can take up to 12 months to complete.



COURSE / CAREER DETAILS

This Australian Apprenticeship is designed to provide people who are entering the Bicycle Industry with specialist Bicycle repair skills and qualifications.

This Vocation will involve many practical tasks including servicing and repairing components from all bicycle systems including wheels, tyres, suspension, steering, drivetrains, brakes, frames and accessories.

Trainees in some bicycle shops may be required to have considerable contact with customers, including assessing bicycles for repair, selling parts and accessories and also selling new and possibly used bicycles.

The course can be structured to meet the needs of the specific enterprise and be either service specific or include some sales electives.

Participants will be required to operate within a safe working environment. Good customer contact and communication skills are also an important aspect of this qualification.

This vocation can provide numerous career paths including:

- Specialising as a Qualified Bicycle Service Person
- Continue studying to gain Certificate III Bicycle Sales or Mechanics Qualifications
