## PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Automotive Vehicle Servicing qualification is an excellent specialist vocation and also provides a career entry opportunity for people who are considering articulation into any of the automotive mechanical trades including vehicle, plant and heavy diesel vocations.

Trainees will be required to operate within a safe working environment. Good customer contact and communication skills are also an important aspect of this Australian Apprenticeship.
