COURSE / CAREER DETAILS

This Australian Apprenticeship is designed to provide people who are entering the Automotive Industry with Automotive Tyre Fitting skills and qualifications.

This Vocation will involve many practical tasks including fitting of new tyres to passenger, light commercial and small industrial vehicles.

It may also include providing advice to customers on the most appropriate tyres and wheels for their vehicle. It will also include fitting of new wheels including alloy wheels to customer vehicles.

A Tyre Fitter will repair and replace tubes and tyres plus balance wheel and tyre assemblies.

Tyre Fitters will need to develop skills in determining tyre wear so they can provide advice to clients on additional work that may be necessary on their vehicle such as wheel alignment or the rectification of faults, faults in steering/suspension components

Trainees will be required to operate within a safe working environment. Good customer contact and communication skills are also an important aspect of this Australian Apprenticeship.

This vocation can provide numerous career paths including:

- Specialising as a Qualified Mechanical Tyre Fitter, Light
- Supervision or Management in an Automotive Retail Tyre Business
- Continue studying to gain Automotive Mechanical Technology Qualifications
- Continue studying to gain Wheel Alignment Qualifications
