The Vehicle Dismantling Vocational course is part of the Nationally Recognised Automotive Training Package AUR 05.

The components of a National Training Package are:-

- Units which define skills and knowledge required to perform specific tasks in the workplace
- Nationally Recognised Qualifications related to workplace requirements and based on industry Competency Standards

PROGRAM INFORMATION

Vehicle Dismantling training is available as an Australian Apprenticeship through Quality Automotive Training.

The training is available using a number of delivery options designed to meet your specific requirements. These options are:

1. Day Release, 1 day per week
2. Block Release, 1 week per month
3. A combination of above with on-site training and assessment
4. Open Learning training delivery with on-site training and assessment

It is anticipated the program can take up to 12 months to complete.

COURSE / CAREER DETAILS

This Australian Apprenticeship is designed to provide people who are entering the Automotive Industry with specialist Vehicle Dismantling skills and qualifications.

This Vocation will involve many practical tasks including working in a Dismantling or Paint and Panel business and removing vehicle components for repair or replacement and also for resale.

Damaged components would either be repaired or new components would be selected and refitted.

A Vehicle Dismantler must be able to identify automotive components and have an understanding of how they work to ensure they can provide the best possible advice and assistance to their customers.

When a vehicle is being dismantled and the components stored for resale, it would be necessary to label all parts and store them in the correct manner on shelves or in specially designed racks.

It is often necessary to carry out fault diagnosis and test mechanical/electrical components and provide a brief report on their condition. This could include running engines prior to their removal from a vehicle and testing electrical components such as fans, starter motors and batteries.

A Vehicle Dismantler may also need to operate a small engine crane and forklift when moving heavy components.

Thermal and mechanical cutting is often a skill required to remove damaged panels prior to removing other components.

Trainees will be required to operate within a safe working environment. Good customer contact and communication skills are also an important aspect of this Australian Apprenticeship.

This vocation can provide numerous career paths including:

- Specialising as a Qualified Vehicle Dismantler
- Supervision or Management of a Vehicle Dismantling Business
- Continue studying to gain Automotive Mechanical Technology or Automotive Vehicle Body Trade Qualifications
