- Units which define skills and knowledge required to perform specific tasks in the workplace.
- Nationally Recognised Qualifications related to workplace requirements and based on industry Competency Standards.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

Vehicle Presentation training is available as an Australian Apprenticeship through Quality Automotive Training.

The training is available using a number of delivery options designed to meet your specific requirements. These options are:

1. Day Release, 1 day per week.
2. Block Release, 1 week per month.
3. A combination of above with on-site training and assessment.
4. Open Learning training delivery with on-site training and assessment.

It is anticipated the program can take up to 12 months to complete.

COURSE / CAREER DETAILS

This Australian Apprenticeship is designed to provide people who are entering the Automotive Industry with specialist Vehicle Presentation skills and qualifications.

This Vocation may involve many practical tasks including restoring a used vehicle to its original condition by cleaning, buffing and polishing the exterior of the vehicle and by vacuuming and steam cleaning the interior of the vehicle including seats and carpets.

It will also be necessary to clean underneath the vehicle and to carefully clean the engine bay. Vehicle Detailers may also apply underbody paint to the chassis and under fenders. They may also complete minor paint touch ups and refit mouldings and mud flaps.

If a Vehicle Detailer works for a new car franchise they will also be required to prepare new vehicles for customer delivery as part of the pre delivery service and for the showroom.

Vehicle Presentation requires strict attention to detail to ensure a vehicle is thoroughly inspected at the completion of the job to ensure all exterior polish is removed, window glass cleaned and hand marks cleaned.

Trainees will be required to operate within a safe working environment. Good customer contact and communication skills are also an important aspect of this Australian Apprenticeship.

This vocation can provide numerous career paths including:

- Specialising as a Qualified Vehicle Detailer
- Supervision or Management of a Vehicle Detailing Specialist Business
- Continue studying to gain Automotive Vehicle Body Trade Qualification
