PROGRAM INFORMATION

Certificate III in Bicycles training is available as an Australian Apprenticeship through Quality Automotive Training.

The training is available using a number of delivery options designed to meet your specific requirements. These options are:

1. Day Release, 1 day per week
2. Block Release, 1 week per month
3. A combination of above with on-site training and assessment
4. Open Learning training delivery with on-site training and assessment

It is anticipated the program can take up to 48 months to complete.



COURSE / CAREER DETAILS

This Australian Apprenticeship is designed to provide people who are entering the Bicycle Industry or who already work in the industry with specialist Bicycle Repair skills and qualifications.

Participants will be required to operate within a safe working environment. Good customer contact and communication skills are also an important aspect of this qualification.

This Vocation will involve many practical tasks including servicing and repairing components from all bicycle systems including wheels, tyres, suspension, steering, drivetrains, brakes, frames and accessories.

Trainees in some bicycle shops may be required to have considerable contact with customers, including assessing bicycle for repair, selling parts and accessories and also selling new and possibly used bicycles.

Other bicycle retailers may prefer their trainee to specialise in mechanical work and include more complex skills such as wheel rebuilds, suspension rebuilds, hydraulic brake repairs and repairs and modifications to bicycle frames.

The course can be structured to meet the needs of the specific enterprise and be either mechanical specific or include some sales electives.

This vocation can provide numerous career paths including:

- Specialising as a Qualified Bicycle Mechanic
- Supervision or Management of a Retail Bicycle Business
